LEMONT KEEPATAW DAY FOOD VENDOR GUIDELINES

It is the goal of the Lemont Keepataw Day Food and Beverage Committee that the community be provided with the broadest possible choice of food products with the smallest degree of duplication.

Guidelines

1. Date: Sunday, September 6, 2026 from 2:00 pm - 11:00 pm. All food vendors will need to be set up and ready for inspection by 11:15 am.
2. Vendors agree to comply with the festival schedule for the operation of the food booth/truck. Vendor also agrees to have a representative at the site for inspection by the Village of Lemont at 12:00 pm on Sunday, September 6, 2026. Failure to have the proper inspection will result in the elimination of your food truck/booth from operating during the Fest.
3. Vendors will be given a 17' x 30' space at the fest.
 - a. Booths, and tents must have a minimum of 20-pound weights on each leg.
 - b. Vendors must have a fire extinguisher within their assigned location.
 - c. Vendors will be given assigned space day of fest. All trailers must be unhitched prior to inspection. Any vehicle accompanying the trailer will be given a parking space in our vendor parking lot.
 - d. Lemont Keepataw will NOT be able to supply electrical services. Please plan accordingly.
 - e. Village of Lemont requires a valid business license on site upon inspection. THIS CAN BE FROM THE COUNTY IN WHICH VENDOR IS REGISTERED IN.
 - f. Vendor must not pour anything down storm sewers, portable toilets, or on grounds.
 - g. Vendors are responsible for removing their own trash from the assigned location. A dumpster will be available on site.
 - h. Hand washing stations will be provided nearby.
4. Vendor should supply a copy of their Logo and Menu so we may add to our website and social media for promotion.
5. NO ALCOHOL MAY BE SOLD BY VENDOR.

Liability

1. Lemont Keepataw Day is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
2. Lemont Keepataw Day is not responsible for the cancellation of the fun fest due to circumstances beyond their control. This includes but is not limited to natural disaster, severe weather pandemics, acts of war, strike or acts of God.
3. Vendor agrees to pay for any damages done by it or its agents and employees to any personal or real property provided by or through the Lemont Keepataw Day Committee at the fest.
4. Vendor, its employees, and agents agree to indemnify, defend save, and hold harmless the loss, costs, expenses, demands, taxes, claims, damages, lawsuits, proceedings, or cause of action, including workers compensation claims, of any kind or nature whatsoever, including reasonable attorneys' fees and cost of defense.
